

# Pickett Park

## Garbage and Recycling Information

- **Pickett Park garbage service is provided by a private company. The large metal dumpster is emptied once a week.** Place all garbage inside the dumpster and be sure to **bag all garbage and keep sliding doors closed.** We have had rodent infestations in the past, so it is very important to follow these guidelines and keep the areas clean.

**If you are not sure that something is recyclable, please place in the dumpster.**

- **Bulky Items Do not leave any items outside the dumpster or recycle bins.** Anything requiring a special pick-up must be arranged in advance by contacting our CAS Management Rep: Jennifer@CASNC.com There is a charge for this service.

- **Recycling Each unit has one assigned blue recycling bin.** You may keep the bin in the garbage dumpster area but be sure to mark it with your unit number. Use only your own bin- do not place items in any other bin.

**If you need a recycling bin,** contact Durham One Call at 919-560-1200 and they will deliver one to your unit.

**Recycling pick-up is usually every other Thursday;** however, holidays may affect the pick-up date. There is an app called COD Rollout that will send a reminder the day before bins should be placed at curb for collection.

**If you keep your recycling bin at your unit -** The bin should be rolled out for collection at the curb and then returned to a storage location.

**Bins should not be kept in front of the unit or in sight of the street.**

### **General Recycling Guidelines:**

- Leave recyclables loose in the bin- don't bag or bundle anything.
- No plastic bags, wrapping, Styrofoam or plastic packing of any kind.
- Break down and flatten cardboard boxes.
- Items should be clean and dry – no residue from food, paint, grease, pesticides, etc.
- No Fast-Food containers, Pizza Boxes, or Egg Cartons.
- No Pet Waste/Baby Diapers
- No Paper Towels/Napkins/Tissues.
- No #6 plastics.
